



RCT 100 CLUB RULES / SCHEME

The following will be the Lottery Rules:

1. The scheme will be operated as a “Private Society Lottery” as defined below
2. The purpose of the lottery is to raise funds for the benefit of the community of Rhynie.
3. RCT reserves the right to alter The Rules from time to time, with a 1 month notice period.
4. A copy of The Rules will be available from our website: www.rhyniecharitabletrust.co.uk
5. The Lottery will be limited to 100 participants over the age of 16 years.
6. The stake will be **£5 per month, payable by Standing Order**, see below (a) on **the 1st day of each month**, for the draw later that month. Single annual payments of £60 may also be made by cash or cheque. Alternatively, we will call to collect the monies at the start of each month.
7. Participants may join the scheme at anytime during the year, see 8 below
8. Participants will be included in the draw if the appropriate stake has been received by the promotor by the 10th of the month in which the draw is taking place.
9. **The minimum commitment to the lottery is 1 year.** Members are encouraged to set up one of the following:
 - a. Standing Order agreement, see cancellation option 18. Below
 - b. Annual payment by cheque. Cheque to be made payable to Rhynie Charitable Trust
10. On receipt of the first monthly/annual payment & Registration Form the participant will be asked to draw a number.
11. For each additional entry to the lottery a new, unique Draw Number will be allocated.
12. A draw will take place monthly on the **last Friday of the month and 4 prizes will be available.** Prize-winners will be notified by the Lottery promoter and the results of the draw will be published on the village notice board and on our website.
13. **Prizes will be paid by cash or cheque** to the stakeholder named on the Lottery Registration Form.
14. The first draw will be carried out by a member of the community. Subsequent draws will be made by the winnerth of the previous draw (where available). Alternatively we will ask another member of the community to draw the number.
15. In the event of there being less than 100 participants in the draw, the total prize monies shall be awarded as 55% of the total value of the funds received for that monthly draw. The 55% prize money will be split as follows: 1st prize – 56%; 2nd prize – 20%, 3rd and 4th prizes 12% each
16. Members may cancel their entry to the Lottery at any time (following the minimum 12 month period) by giving **1 month’s written notice to The Lottery Promotor**. Standing Orders should be managed directly with Members’ bank.
17. The Club reserves the right to re-allocate and or withdraw any Draw Number where payment has not been received on time.
18. Any decision by RCT to wind up the “Rhynie 100 Club” will be by one month’s written notice.
19. The Lottery Promoter and Trust Secretary shall be responsible for completing the returns to Aberdeenshire Council

(a) The “RCT 100 Club” bank account will be operated as a separate ledger within our main RCT account.
